Amphibious RIB

When associate editor Kevin Koenig and I took Sealegs, a RIB with wheels, out for a test on the Hudson River, there were already stares and points before we'd even cast off. But the biggest reactions came when we drove up the launch ramp at Liberty State Park in New Jersey. Yes, drove. With a few simple lever movements, the boat's three wheels descended and we simply drove up onto land.

Sealegs is a recent import from Australia and a recent crossover from the military market. It's currently making a splash as a second boat for coastal dwellers or owners of larger yachts, which just might make it the next generation of megayacht tender. (price upon request; www.sealegs.com)

Many megayachts carry jet skis onboard because of their versatility and the on-the-water fun they offer, and the Sea Doo GTI does not disappoint. It can seat three comfortably, which makes getting to shore easy. It also features a tow eye so you can attach a tow rope for waterskiing. For ease of handling, the GTI has reverse on the left-hand side and the throttle on the right, which allows for two-handed control.
